
THE COLD WAR

In 1917, the Bolshevik Revolution eliminated rule by the czar's family and established rule by the communist party in Russia. The leader of the Bolsheviks was \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (see top right photo  $\Rightarrow$ ). Russia renamed the territory it controlled the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, or the U.S.S.R. for short. Upon his unexpected death in 1924, the Russian communist party was taken over by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (lower photo). "Uncle Joe," as he was called in the U.S. as our ally during World War II, remained the leader of the USSR until his death in 1953.

FYI: China, the USSR's neighbor to the south, became a communist nation in 1949, just after WWII. At first, the two nations were allies. However, the Soviet Union and China had border disputes; Stalin and Mao Zedong (photo, left) also had ideological differences about how communism should be practiced because China was more agricultural and Russia was more industrialized. By 1960 the two nations were no longer allies.
