The Roman Colosseum

Overview

The Colosseum was one of the greatest feats of Roman engineering and a model for the ages. The name comes from the Latin word *colossus*, meaning gigantic. For centuries after its opening in A.D. 80, excited spectators, both rich and poor, cheered a variety of free, bloody spectacles presented for their entertainment.

Assignment

Each student, along with a partner, will be asked to research the Roman Colosseum and compare it to a modern day stadium. After researching, the students will put their information on a poster board, give the class a brief summary of their work, and then display the project in the classroom.

What to Include

Each group should include the following information in their project:

- -Titles of the stadiums
- -Pictures of the stadiums
- -Years stadiums were constructed
- -Size of stadiums
- -Seating capacity of stadiums
- -Special features of the stadiums
- -Events that take place in stadiums
